Construction Update



East Ramp Construction

East Ramp pavement work is anticipated to begin in mid-June. The construction will take 3 months. Skill Aviation and East Ramp tenants will be operating out of the FBO and South Ramp for the summer.

South Hangar Taxi Lane 3

Taxi lane 3 construction is to begin by mid-June. This is Phase I of a multiple phase program to rehabilitate the south hangar pavements which are some of the worst pavement conditions on the airport. Stay tuned for additional rehabilitation construction to take place in 2025.



Main Parking Lot Rehabilitation

The main parking lot will be rehabilitated this fall. It is the final piece of the complete rehabilitation of the airport's main entrance. McAree Road was recently resurfaced and a sidewalk installed from Edgewood Avenue to the main parking lot.

Signature Aviation rehabilitated the FBO building, pavements, and landscaping. South ramp blue hangars will also be rehabilitated and painted.

Also added next to the main parking lot are bleachers and a speaker broadcasting live ATC for aviation enthusiasts to observe and listen.
